1. Economics and Personal Finance will be offered to students in grades 10 to 12. Successful completion of this class will open up an additional elective spot in student schedules for the 2017-2018 school year and allow students the opportunity to pursue other courses of interest. This course will be taught using a blended model of online and direct instruction. Ideal candidates for this class are students who have a strong work ethic and are highly motivated. Students will receive direct instruction from 8 to 11:30 each morning. The afternoon session will be a combination of online module work and small group help sessions. Students completing this course will have the opportunity to take the W!SE test. Cost: Tuition - \$680 (Reduced Lunch \$340 or Free Lunch \$68)

- 2. <u>Geometry Honors</u> will be offered to rising 9th and 10th graders who meet the following criteria: A/B in Algebra 1 HN, Pass Advanced on Algebra 1 SOL and teacher nominated. This class is specifically being offered to give students the opportunity to enroll in accelerated math and sciences courses during their junior and senior years. This course will be taught using a variety of instruction such as direct instruction, inquiry-based instruction, problembased instruction, etc. Throughout the day there will be a combination of online modules, small group work and individual work sessions. **Cost: Tuition \$780 (Reduced Lunch \$390 or Free Lunch \$78)**
