Partners for Safe Teen Driving:

Oakton HS Dates or Adult and Community Education

Classroom Driver Education:

- 1. Passing Letter Grade
- 2. Pass Final DE Exam
- 3. Attend PSTD

DMV Learner's Permit Test:

- Student must be at least 15 years 6 months before taking permit test
- Take at DMV or <u>Oakton HS</u> <u>DMV Permit Testing Dates</u>
- Student does NOT have to complete Driver Ed class before getting the learner's permit

DEC-District 8 (Pink Card)

- Cards are distributed by DE classroom teachers after completing all requirements
- Pink card is NOT needed to obtain the leaner permit.

After DMV Learner's Permit is Acquired:

- Student can drive with supervising parent/guardian
- Log 45 hours including 15 hours after sunset

Logging supervised driving:

At this stage, your log does not need to be completed to take Behind the Wheel, however, it is strongly recommended you have some previous driving experience with your parents in various situations before attending Behind the Wheel.

Behind the Wheel:

- Must have learner's permit
- Must have pink card
- Take with a private company or through <u>Adult and Community</u> Education at Oakton HS

To Obtain Temporary Driver's License (TDL):

- At this point, 45 hour driving log must be completed
- Must have held Learner's Permit for a minimum of 9 months
- Pass Behind the Wheel Road Skills Test

Permanent VA Driver License:

Must hold valid TDL for 6 months
